DTS AND SCENARIST PARTNER TO PROMOTE ULTRA HD BLU-RAY

Enter Technology Integration and Global Distribution Agreement for DTS:X and Digital Bridge

LAS VEGAS (April 14, 2015) – [DTS](#) (Nasdaq: DTSI), a leader in high-definition audio enhancement technologies, and [Scenarist, LLC](#), the developer of Hollywood-standard professional Blu-ray Disc authoring systems, have announced a technology integration and distribution partnership to include the DTS:X Encoder and the DTS BD Digital Bridge Tool Suite with the latest version of Scenarist BD Professional authoring software. Scenarist will also integrate the Digital Bridge Tools functionality into its Scenarist UHD system being developed to support Ultra HD Blu-ray.

Digital Bridge, a new feature included in the format extensions announced by the Blu-ray Disc Association in 2014, will enable end-users to legitimately export Blu-ray Disc and Ultra HD Blu-ray content to secure storage devices such as hard discs, thumb-drives and other electronic formats. The DTS BD Digital Bridge Tool Suite that will be integrated with Scenarist authoring systems facilitates the production process necessary to enable this feature.
